

<b>CALIFORNIA</b>	AB 1279	Title Protection Bill passed Assembly and Senate. Waiting on Governor to sign. Simply protects the MT-BC credential. Does not restrict practice in anyway, so no need for exemption language.
<b>FLORIDA</b>	SB 1310/HB 1245	License; Passed one committee but ran out of time; Will have to be re-introduced in 2016
<b>ILLINOIS</b>	SB 1595	Study bill signed by Governor. Creates a group to look into the need for a state license.
<b>IOWA</b>	HF 380/SSB 1212	License bill on hold until 2016.
<b>MINNESOTA</b>	Resubmitting	License; bill did not progress this session and will be discussed in 2016. AMTA will offer changes to the exemption language to bring it into alignment with the language verbiage already approved by the NSBTM and AMTA.
<b>MISSOURI</b>	HB 189/SB 154	License bill on hold until 2016.
<b>NEW JERSEY</b>	A4353	License; bill introduced in both the House and the Senate. Waiting to hear if the bills will be heard in committee in the lame duck session in November.

<b>OHIO</b>	HB 546	License; Licensure bill testimony provided in June. Still in a holding pattern.
<b>OREGON</b>	HB 2796	License; Passed out of first committee; Waiting for hearing in next committee
<b>PENNSYLVANIA</b>	AWAITING BILL NUMBER	License; bill filed in House and Senate. Not sure if it will be heard in committee this fall.
<b>SOUTH CAROLINA</b>	SB 589	Licensure; First hearing on 5/20

CO, ID and TX had resolutions introduced in 2015 which simply state that music therapy is a valid healthcare service.
